Learning

As a learner, over time the children will learn

to:

Take risks to engage in a variety of opportunities and experiences offered,
Develop and discover interests, and talents.
Promoting resilience, confidence and independence.
Develop the confidence to ask questions and enquire further detail on things they would like to know more about. *(No question is a silly question)*

When learners leave Willow Grove they will have had opportunities to:

Access appropriately a variety of 'real life' experiences, and activities.
Engage in opportunities in school and within the local area and community.
Develop aspirations and thinking for the future.
Access and celebrate social and cultural opportunities.
Be accepting and resilient when faced with diversity.
Become a responsible, respectful member of the community.
