

Pupil Premium Grant at Willow Grove School.

The Pupil Premium Grant is a grant given to all schools for the following groups of children.

- Children in Reception to Year 6 who are, or have ever been, entitled to free school meals based on their family income.
- Children in care.
- Children previously in care who have been adopted, or who have a special guardianship order, a child arrangements order or a residence order.
- Children recorded as being from service families.

The pupil premium grant is funding provided to schools to help all pupils reach their full potential, regardless of their background or financial situation.

At Willow Grove School the Pupil Premium grant is used in several different ways and can be responsive to the needs of the individual child. We are continually looking for creative interventions and support mechanisms for our children and their families.

We try to offer a whole range of support to the children and their families.

Currently at Willow Grove this includes:

Additional staff, either on a temporary or permanent basis to provide additional emotional, relational, behavioural or academic support.

An individual voice for children who are looked after
